### Outline

Pick up a matching card, 'PON!" Make 2 matching sets, 'WIN!' Play your KOBANS to the end!

✓ All players start each hand with 5 cards

**OBABA** ✓ The goal is to collect 2 sets of 3 matching cards. The OBABA card can be used as a wild card for any suit.



- ✓ Players draw a card from the pile or pick up a card discarded (discard) by another player. Discard one uneeded card face up in the discard pile.
- ✓ When a discard is picked up to complete a set of 3 matching cards, the player explains PON! The cards are then placed face up in front of the player.
- ✓ When a player has collected 2 sets of 3 cards of the same suit the player exclaims WIN! That hand is concluded.
- ✓ The winning player receives (a) KOBAN(s). When the DORAYAKI chip matches your card, you score bonus points!
- ✓ Play until one player has no KOBANs remaining The player who has the most KOBANs wins the match.

[Hand] Cards each players holds. One play reaching WIN! or No Result. [Pile] Cards placed in the center. [Draw] Card (s) taken from the pile. [Discards] Discarded cards next to the pile. [PON!] Exclaimed when claiming a discard. [WIN!] Exclaimed when 2 sets of 3 cards the same suit are matched for a win. [DORAYAKI] Chip showing the Kanji for a bonus point. [Pot] Penalty KOBANs placed in the center.

## Preparation

### Cards, KOBANs and DORAYAKI chips


- · Remove 2 OBABA cards from the pack. Shuffle the remaining 36 kanji cards and 2 OBABA cards.
- · Each player is given 5 KOBANS.
- · DORAYAKI chips are placed in the center.

### Deciding the first dealer

· The first dealer is decided by 'rock scissors paper.'









#### Game start

- The dealer deals each player 5 cards face down (hand). The remaining cards are placed in the center (pile).
- · Select 1 DORAYAKI chip and turn it face up.
- · Each hand is played from the dealer.

### Overview

- · The goal is to collect 2 sets of 3 cards the same suit (WIN!).
- · The OBABA card serves as a wild card and can be used in place of any one card.
- · Each player draws a card from the center pile and discards one card on their turn.
- · The game is played clockwise.

Players may miss a turn upon PON! being claimed.

### PON!: Claiming a discard

- If a discard makes a set of 3 in any player's hand that player can claim PON!
- · The 3 cards are placed face up in front of the player.
- · The player discards one card.
- · Play restarts from the player to the immediate left of the player who claimed PON!

### No result

- If the pile is exhausted and no **WIN!** is claimed that hand is concluded. The same dealer continues for the next hand.
- Following a no result hand 1 OBABA card is added to the deck. In the event of another no result, another OBABA card is added to the deck (2 extra cards in total). Upon reaching WIN! any extra cards are removed from the deck.



- · Repeat play. The match reaches a conclusion when any one player has lost all KOBANS.
- The player with the most KOBANs is declared the winner.

### What if ......

### 3 matching cards are dealt or drawed?

The player can choose whether the cards are placed face up in front or not as a tactical move.

### PON! or WIN! is claimed by more than one player?

PON! Vs. WIN!, WIN! takes precedence. PON! Vs. PON!, the player closest to the previous player's left takes precedence. WIN! Vs. WIN!, winner is decided by 'rock, paper, scissors.'

### PON! or WIN! is claimed with unmatching cards?

That player receives a penalty and places 1 KOBAN in the pot and the hand is concluded. The winner of the next hand wins the pot as well as any other KOBAN owed.

### A player mistakenly holds too many or too few cards?

That player will receive a penalty and 1 KOBAN is placed in the pot and that hand is concluded.
